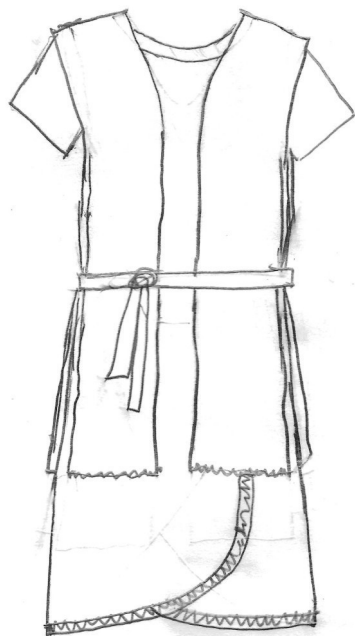
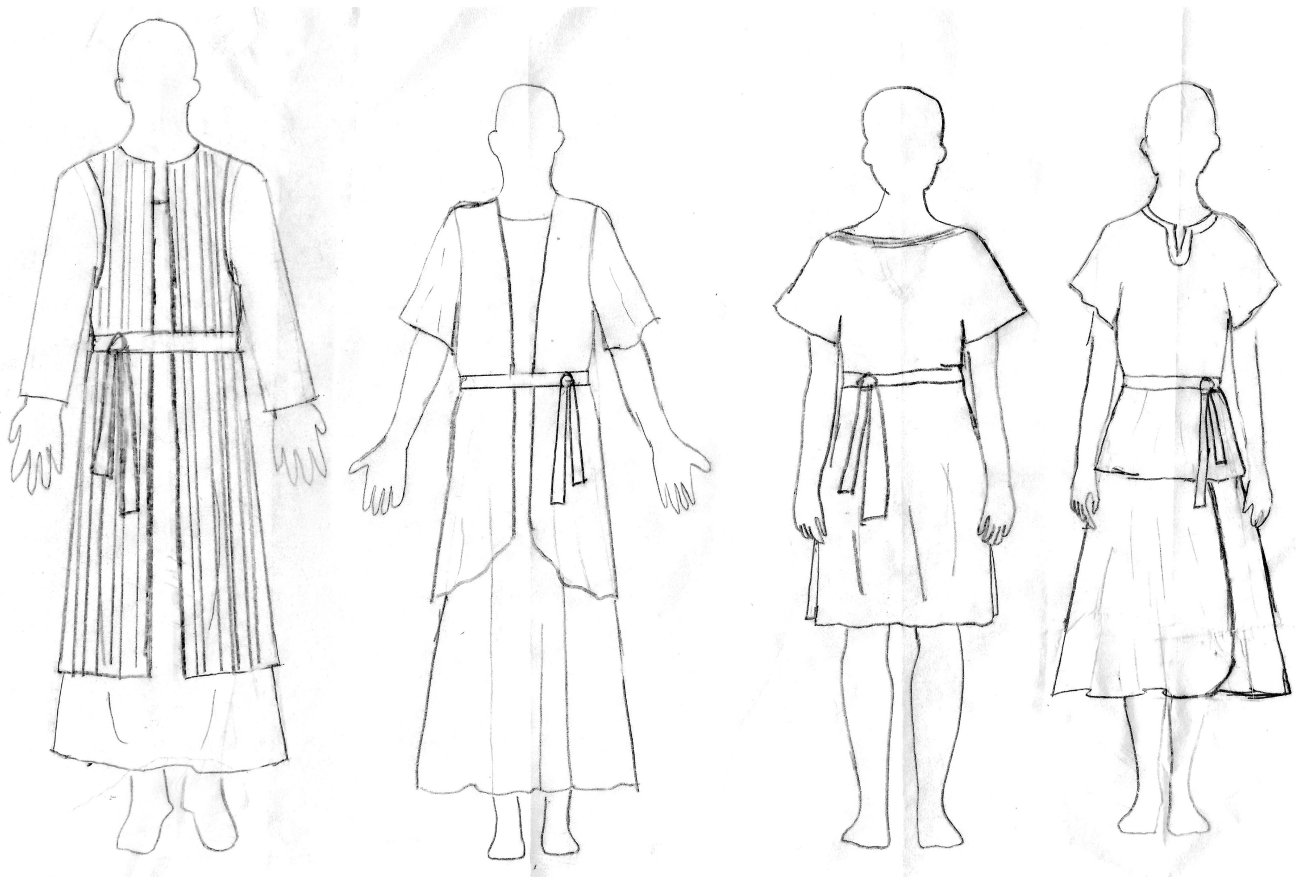


Hi Peoria Stake Youth & Leaders,

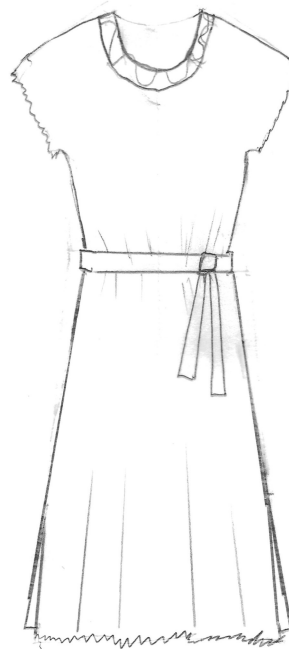
This is Laurel Johnson in the Centennial Ward. I am delighted to be able to help with clothing for the upcoming Journey. Everybody will be arranging their own outfits, but I am willing to offer as much help as needed with this process. I have put together a few guidelines and ideas so you will know what we have in mind, and to get your creativity going. Some things to consider:

- For Daughters & Sons the length of the lower clothing (i.e. robe, skirt, wrap, tunic) should be no shorter than knee length and no longer than ankle length. If you opt for ankle length or a slim design, you may want side slits for easier hiking.
- Plan on wearing shorts under your outfit. You may also want to wear a t-shirt under your upper clothing (i.e. top, tunic, vest, robe) depending on the design you choose.
- Only 1 Journey outfit per person is necessary but you can bring extra shorts and t-shirts to have a set a clean clothes under.
- For Abbas & Imas the length of the lower clothing (i.e. robe, skirt, wrap, tunic) could be between mid-calf and ankle length to look more Jerusalem-ish.
- Since it will likely be warm, light weight fabrics will be best
- There are lots of options for choosing designs from a simple no-sew tunic, to thrift store hunting, to more involved patterns requiring some sewing skills.
- If there is someone who would like a design that needs to be sewed, but doesn't have the skills or equipment we will try to make it happen. Ward leaders might want to reach out to find local seamstresses who are willing to help.
- If any ward is interested in having a Young Men/Women activity where the youth can sew something or make no-sew tunics I am happy to come facilitate that.
- As you look at the picture use your imagination. These are not requirements, just ideas. There's plenty of other ideas that would work but for all the pictures below, I have patterns.
- If anyone wants to use any of the designs, you can contact me and let me know your needs, and I will trace a tissue paper pattern for you to keep.
- All of the tops, vests, robes, tunics can be any length. For instance if you like a top, but you wish it was knee length so you only need one item, I can make the pattern longer, or if you want a robe to be shorter, no problem.
- All of the upper clothing can have any neckline shape, or sleeve length, and sleeves can be omitted.
- Very simple designs can be made to look fancier by adding trim to the neck/sleeves/hemline.

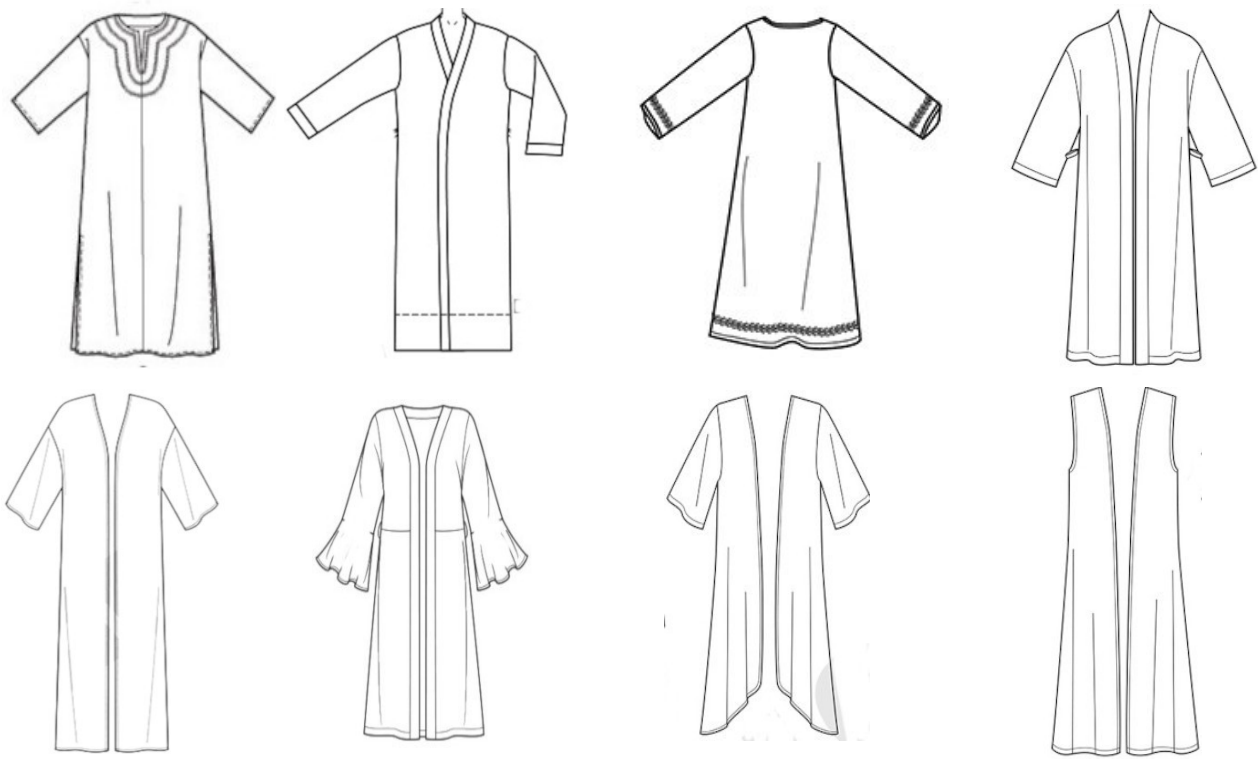


No sew tunic and wrap over shorts and t-shirt

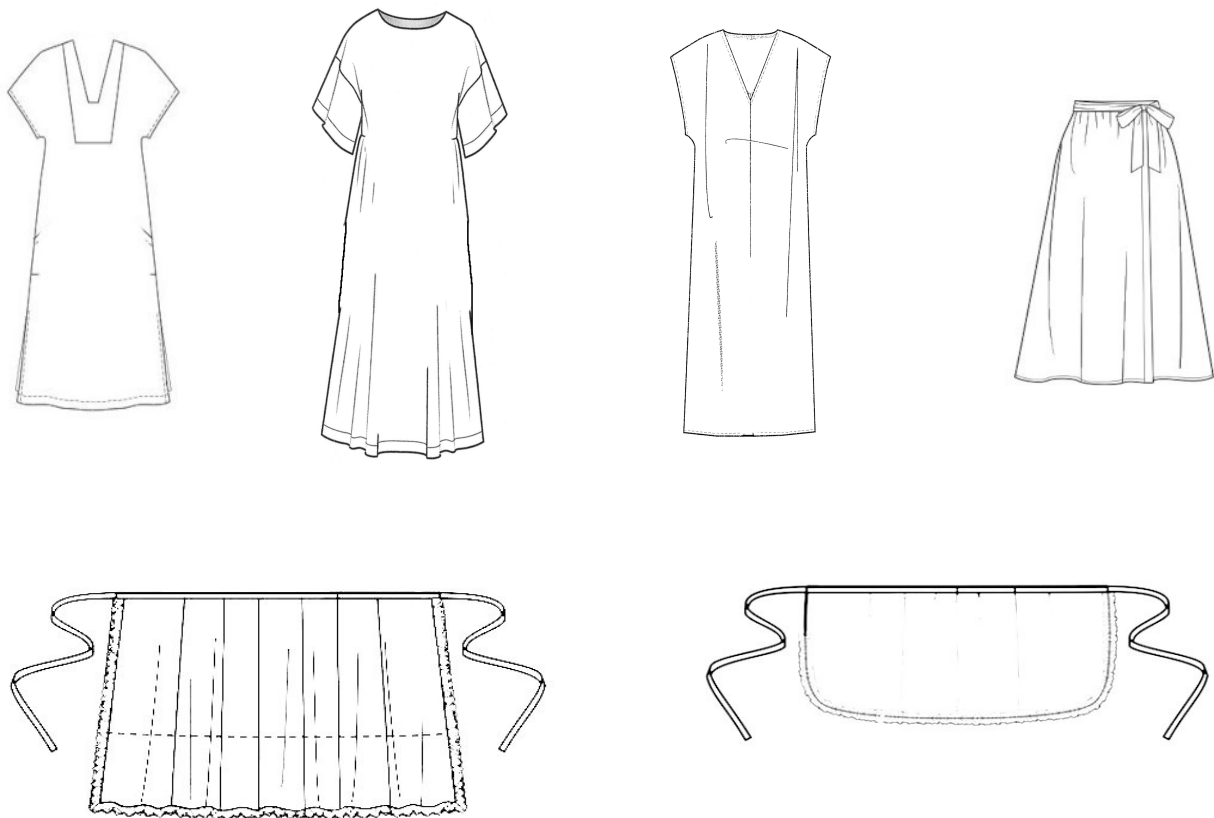


Simple un-hemmed dress
